

Volunteers Needed!

Loddon Community Cinema was started in 2009. While some of the original team have moved on, the present small group of volunteers have been involved in running the group since then: John McCormack (Projectionist), Roy Russell (Treasurer) and Jane Hale (Refreshments) with help from Ros McCormack and Larry Dainty. Between them, they cover the following tasks:

Select and book films suitable for our audience.

Publicity – posters; handouts; email alerts; website; listing with Screen East and BFI; Pre-show PowerPoint.

Tickets – print, deliver and collect tickets from Loddon Garden & DIY. Sell at door.

Hall – book dates with Church Office, prepare seats, screen, blinds etc. Clear up after show.

Projection - set up and run projector, disc player and amplifier.

Refreshments - purchase stock and serve before film and in interval.

Treasurer - count takings, report attendance to distributor and Screen East. Bank takings and pay distributor, hall and Parravanis.

If the Cinema is to continue, we need new people to replace the current team (though tasks can be shared according to number of volunteers and skills available). A handover period of training can be arranged and support is always available through the BFI and Creative Arts East.
